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### Photographic Sources and Abbreviations

Inscriptifact Photographs: The prefix “ISO\_DO” denotes an image from the Inscriptifact online database, managed by the West Semitic Research Project (<http://www.inscriptfact.com>). These images are of exceptionally high quality and there is typically more than one image for a given fragment. Currently, the images in this collection represent only cols. 0–1, or J. T. Milik’s original 1Q20.

Israel Museum Photographs: The Shrine of the Book at the Israel Museum kindly allowed access to their photographic negatives for this edition. Included in these are both the older, original photographs and more recent ones. Images from this collection are preceded by either “IMneg.” or “IMneg.x.”

Bearman and Zuckerman Photographs: In 1994 Gregory Bearman and Bruce and Kenneth Zuckerman took a very helpful set of narrowband infrared photographs of those portions of the Genesis Apocryphon housed at the Shrine of the Book. These are prefixed with “BZ” in the notes.

Bearman Photographs: Gregory Bearman took another set of images in 1997, which have been utilized in a limited number of places, particularly in cols. 7–8.
